The Harbour Authority Association of British Columbia (HAABC) will award one \$500.00 academic scholarship annually to a qualified individual who is graduating high school and intends to enrol in a British Columbia post-secondary program in marine education or harbour operations and development **OR** to a qualified individual who is already enrolled in such a program.

The HAABC offers this scholarship in memory of Dick Maughan, in recognition of his contributions to the implementation and success of the HAABC.

The mandate of the HAABC is to establish communication between Harbour Authorities, foster a good working relationship and exchange information and network.

Application forms for this scholarship are available in print at HAABC member harbour offices and online at the HAABC website (www.haa.bc.ca). Instructions accompany the application form. Only complete applications will be reviewed.

The deadline for receipt of applications is June 30th each year. The scholarship award will be adjudicated by the HAABC Executive and announced no later than July 31st. All recipients will be required to provide proof of acceptance into a post secondary institution prior to funds being released.
